OPERATIONS

Fifty members of the Logistics Squadron performed their annual training at Lajes Air Base, Azores. Two major tasks they assisted with were redistributing materials in the supply Facility to increase available warehouse space and improving the overall condition of the bases vehicle fleet.

The supply people developed and executed a plan which resulted in a 75 percent increase in

available warehouse space. This task was estimated by the Base to have taken six to eight weeks for completion. It was completed in less than two weeks.

Vehicles Maintenance personnel also combined fire fighting and ground refueling capability of the base and was 94 percent deficient. Overall the entire base vehicle fleet was in serious disrepair. Vehicle Maintenance personnel improved the fire fighting capability by 25 percent, the refueling capability by 100 percent and vehicles down for maintenance reduced by 48 percent. The Logistics Squadron personnel were rewarded for their efforts with new training programs that are cost effective which saves dollars.
