A November 1, 1950 reorganization created the 142 Maintenance and Supply Group, and on

March 1, 1951, additional reorganization created separate maintenance and supply squadrons. The 142 Maintenance Squadron was activated because of Korea; and unit personnel were dispersed throughout the Air Force. The unit reverted to state control on December 1, 1952. In early 1953 the unit was redesignated the 142 Field Maintenance Squadron. The 142 FMS was inactivated on June 1, 1956.

142 Maintenance and Supply Group: Federalized ANG on 2 March 1951 at Geiger Field, WA, and assigned to 142d Fighter-Interceptor Wing; moved to O'Hare International Airport, IL, by 1 May 1951; inactivated on 6 February 1952.
