### EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, a key Or over a paddle Brun in saltire between a knights chess piece Sable, highlighted Silver Gray, fimbriated Argent, in base in chief an arch of eight mullets of the second, all within a narrow border Silver Gray. Attached above the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Silver Gray border and inscribed "MA KA IKE KA MANA" in Silver Gray letters.

Attached below the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Silver Gray border and inscribed "201ST INTELLIGENCE SQUADRON" in Silver Gray letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The key and knights chess piece symbolize intelligence and the steersman's paddle signifies guidance. The eight stars relate to the three Air Force Core Values, the two Hawaii Air National Guard values and the work, knowledge, power, theme of the motto.
