The 315 Training Squadron trains more than 2,200 Air Force officer, enlisted, and Marine Corps enlisted students in collection, analysis, and application of all-source intelligence to plan and execute combat operations. Air Staff Executive Agent to train joint intermediate imagery analysis for all services and national intelligence agencies. Trains foreign officers in intelligence applications. Manages annual budget and training systems in excess of \$18 million.

## EMBLEM



3490 Technical Training Group emblem

315 Training Squadron emblem: Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The checkerboard or chessboard denotes strategy and analysis, the basis of intelligence collecting. The lamp, symbol of knowledge, refers to the mission of the unit – training of the intelligence community to analyze global occurrences. The flames represent the dual training mission – analysis based upon exploiting basic intelligence sources. The crescent is a symbol to denote increasing or growing in knowledge through intelligence collection. The globe reflects the worldwide interest of the intelligence community. The flight symbols signify intelligence support to strategic and tactical air operations. (Approved, 9 June 1988)
