Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 322nd Balloon Company, assigned to the 46th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 546th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated on 16 November 1921 at Jackson, MI. Relocated on 2 June 1925 to Flint, MI. Relocated on 26 September 1932 to Detroit, MI. Redesignated as the 322nd Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
