Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924, assigned to the XIV Corps, and allotted to the Fourth Corps Area. Atlanta, GA, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Designated mobilization training station was Maxwell Field, AL. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 331st Observation Group on 1 October 1933. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
