Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 333rd Balloon Company, assigned to the 49th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 549th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Initiated in February 1922 at San Francisco, CA. Relocated on 28 January 1930 to Los Angeles, CA. Redesignated as the 333rd Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Inactivated on 2 September 1937 by relief of assigned personnel. Reorganized by August 1939 at Los Angeles. Conducted annual summer training at Ross Field, CA. Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
