## **EMBLEM**

Azure, within a wreath of olive branches Or, a cross couped Gules in perspective shaded Gray charged with a Staff of Aesculapius of the second, all within a diminished bordure of the like. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "341ST MEDICAL SUPPORT SQUADRON" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The medical cross and the Staff of Aesculapius symbolize the unit's tradition of medical care excellence to the wing. The olive branch wreath represents the Squadron's compassion and commitment to provide combat ready people and aerospace forces. Their devotion to the comfort and peace of mind of their customers indicates personnel commitment to excellence by unit personnel. (Approved, 28 Oct 1999)
