Initiated on 23 November 1921 at Ithaca, NY. Redesignated as the 354th Observation Squadron on 25 January 1923. Assigned on 31 March 1924 to the 324th Observation Group (XII Corps). Inactivated on 24 January 1930 at Ithaca by relief of personnel. Conducted summer training at Mitchel Field, NY. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
