Operational training unit, 1 Jun 1942-10 Jan 1943 replacement training unit, 11 Jan 1943-1 May 1944.

4 April 1943 B-25C, 41-12634, of the 376th Bomb Squadron (M), ditches in Lake Murray, South Carolina, during skip-bombing practice, after starboard engine failure. Crew of five escapes before Mitchell sinks after seven minutes afloat, about two miles (3 km) west of the Lake Murray Dam in 150 feet of water.
