EMBLEM

On a black disc within a narrow white border, in sinister base an Air Force yellow lamp, detailed gold brown, emitting a cloud of steel gray smoke, highlighted white, to center from which a white genie, detailed steel gray, is emerging, shown from waist up, arms extended grasping in dexter hand three double ended lightning flashes and in sinister hand a missile, all Air Force yellow detailed gold brown. Below emblem a black scroll bordered white. **SIGNIFICANCE** The emblem is symbolic of the squadron and its mission. Day and night wakefulness and alertness are depicted by the black background and white border. The magic lamp denotes the weapons used to deter

any aggressor with the "Genie" representing the tremendous power contained in the weapons. The "Genie" holding the weapon, symbolic of the squadron's mission, and the lightning bolts, depicting the speed with which the Air Force and squadron missions are performed, is representative of the rigid control over the power.
