Redesignated on the 401st Airdrome Company 25 January 1923. Relieved from the Fourth Army 31 March 1924 and assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve. Redesignated on 401st Airdrome Squadron 1 October 1933. Withdrawn from the First Corps Area 5 June 1936 and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Further allotted 5 April 1937 to the Syracuse District, Northern New York Reserve Area. Status: Disbanded 31 May 42.
