EMBLEM



On a disc Celeste, issuant from dexter base a demi-globe Azure axis bendwise sinister, gridlined Sable, circled by two deltas with contrails bendwise sinister on contrary parallel paths Argent turned of the third, in chief a mullet in honor point with two smaller mullets one to dexter and one to chief Or, and in sinister chief the Liberty Bell, Brown detailed of the third, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "EXCELLENCE IS THE STANDARD" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "512TH OPERATIONS SUPPORT FLT" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe and the deltas circling it signify the worldwide scope of operations. The two smaller stars indicate the flying units of the wing supported by the Flight. The larger star is a symbol of the Flight and its role in support of airlift operations. The Liberty Bell indicates the freedoms we enjoy and protect. (Approved, 8 Dec 2003)
