706th Radar Sq (SAGE): activated 8 Dec 57 at Malmstrom AFB, MT, assigned to 29th AD; moved to Dickinson AFS, ND in Jul 58; transferred to Minot ADS 1 Jan 61; redesignated from AC&W Sq to 706th Radar Sq (SAGE) 15 Jul 61; transferred to Great Falls ADS 25 Jun 63; discontinued 25 Jun 65.

This site became operational in 1959 with AN/FPS-3 and AN/FPS-6A radars manned by the 706th AC&W Squadron. A second ANIFPS-GA height-finder radar was added in 1960. By 1963 these radars had been upgraded to AN/FPS-66 and AN/FPS-90 units. Dickinson was removed from service on March 1, 1965.
