MISSION

The 784th Combat Sustainment Group responsibilities range from aircraft safety systems, fuel tanks, ammunition, explosive ordnance disposal, and ground defense, to guided bombs and missiles. The group manages bombs, tanks, countermeasures, explosive ordnance disposal equipment, small arms, medium caliber bullets and containers, and determine requirements, acquisition, item management, engineering, and technical support of all assigned items and components. It supports foreign military sales of various munitions items. The group manages Paveway I, II and III laser-guided bombs; cluster bombs; GBU-15, AGM-130, and AGM-142 precision guided bombs; and various test sets and components; and is the system program office for all Maverick Missiles. The group is also the ammunition control point for all air-to-ground munitions and manages Standard Air Munitions Package/Standard Tanks, Racks, Adaptors, Pylon Package; pre-positioned ammunition ships, and global asset positioning.

The 784th Combat Sustainment Group acquires, manages and provides sustaining engineering support for Air Force air-to-surface munitions; explosive ordnance disposal tools & equipment; aircraft explosive components; and fuel tanks. We control a stockpile worth over \$22B and execute an annual budget exceeding \$550M to support war fighting needs of the US Air Force, Navy, Army, and 76 foreign governments.
