Throughout its existence the group's mission has consisted of providing support in such areas as security police, civil engineering, services, personnel, administration, base operations and training, staff judge advocate, and disaster preparedness. During its tenure at Cannon AFB, NM from October 1957-June 1969 the group also provided supply and transportation support. Those functions at Luke, however, were the responsibility of the Deputy Commander for Resource Management. The 832d Combat Support Group upon its activation at Luke also assumed responsibility, through its subordinate 832d Combat Support Squadron, for operating and maintaining the extensive resources of the Luke Air Force Range whose hub was Gila Bend Air Force Auxiliary Field located some sixty miles southwest of Luke AFB
