### **EMBLEM**



57 Service Group emblem

857 Combat Support Group emblem: Per fess inverted or and azure a dragon rampant similarly counterchanged incensed proper, holding in its claws a spear erect of the last. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and golden yellow are the colors of the USAF. The dragon represents the cunning and endurance of the organization in the performance of its duties, and the spear is symbolic of service, while the flames issuing from the dragon's mouth are representative of the zeal with which the personnel of the organization perform their allotted tasks. (Approved, 1 Mar 1943)
