MISSION

The Group, consisting of 2 squadrons and 4 flights, provides mission support to the 916 Air Refueling Wing and subordinate units with specialists who administer, support, maintain, and train for readiness. The Civil Engineer Squadron provides the physical maintenance of structures and buildings for the Wing. The Security Forces Squadron safeguards the Wing and its assets. The Services Flight, Mission Support Flight, and the Mission Support Flight all provide the administrative foundation for the Wing. The 916 Communications Flight is responsible for all communication pathways of the Wing.
