### MISSION

Provides overall support functions for fuels, transportation, supply and logistics plans. Provides the Wing Deployment Control Center (DCC) and Squadron Readiness Control Center (SRCC) command and control during contingency operations. Develops conventional wing plans and host tenant support agreements. Directs the wing Aerospace Expeditionary Force (AEF) cell and manages wing mobility processes.

## EMBLEM



On a disc per pale Azure and Gules, gridlined sphere Or voided to the field, surmounted by in saltire to sinister a skeleton key, bow of four circles ward to dexter base and to dexter a lightning bolt throughout, all of the third fimbriated Sable; within a narrow Yellow border. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "IN OMNIA PARATUS" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "927TH LOGISTICS READINESS SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine Blue and Air Force Yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The disc is divided into red and blue, the red denoting courage and valor of Air Force personnel. The key represents the unit's guardianship of the supply resources of the Air Force. The unit holds the key that controls procurement, receipt, storage and issue of the critical supplies that are necessary to keep the Air Force operationally ready. The lightning bolt signifies the swiftness of action in responding to the needs of the Air Force. Combined, these elements symbolize the

highest level of logistics support with mission-ready Air personnel, supplies and equipment, in support of contingency operations worldwide. The Latin motto translates to “READY FOR ANYTHING.” (Approved, 4 Apr 2022)
