Members of the 1835th Electronics Installation Squadron from Norton AFB, California, lower the antenna dish into position on the base of the new AN/GPN-20 surveillance radar stand. The radar installation at Zweibrucken AB, West Germany, part of the AN/GPN-24 upgrade program, brought state-of-the-art air traffic control equipment to the 2143d Information Systems Squadron.

A microwave antenna tower was under construction near Building 1267 in the west area of the base. The Norton AFB, California, 1835th Electronics Installation Squadron were building the 110-foot high tower to transmit signals from the base to the Utah Test and Training Range. When complete the antenna would be equipped with a 10-foot parabolic dish. 30 Sep 1983
