OPERATIONS

24 July 1978, a service test reorganization of the 2849th Air Base Group Squadron Section created five squadron sections, namely, the 2849th Security Police Squadron, 2849th Civil Engineering Squadron, Munitions Test HQ Squadron Section of the Directorate of Maintenance, the Directorate of Distribution HQ Squadron Section, and the 2849th ABG HQ Squadron. The reorganization better supported the housing, administration, discipline, and morale needs of military personnel. On 20 July 1979, General Bryce Poe II, HQ AFLC Commander, gave his approval to the newly established squadrons and recommended the organizational structure to other field commanders.

Buildings and facilities on the base were valued at more than \$375 million. A 13,500-foot runway handled an average of more than 120,000 flight operations a year,
