OPERATIONS

16 MAR 1951 AMC designated and organized the 2947 Depot Training Squadron assigned to Ogden AMA. On 1 June 1951 its training function was separated from Ogden's and it became a vehicle to carry trained instructor personnel to administer further classroom and on-the-job training for military personnel.

By 1 June 1951, AMC directed that Headquarters, Ogden AMA and the 2947th be separated administratively because of the difference in their primary functions: Ogden's main concern was with the processing function and basic indoctrination of military personnel; the Squadron, on the other hand, acted as a vehicle for trained instructor personnel to administer further classroom and on-the-job training. Activation of this organization relieved the 25th Air Depot Wing of heavy administrative and training workload and allowed its personnel to work in productive areas and on more advanced training brackets.

On 14 October 1951, AMC discontinued the 2947th, reassigning its functions, personnel, equipment and funds to the newly activated 2949th Depot Training Wing.
