## EMBLEM



35 Civil Engineering Squadron emblem: On a yellow disc edged with a narrow red border a stylized blue aircraft in horizontal flight surmounted by a red engineer's transit . Attached below the disc a blank yellow scroll edged red. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the unit and the Air Force colors, ultramarine blue and golden yellow, are used in the design. The color blue

alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations, and yellow to the sun and excellence of personnel in assigned tasks. The aircraft symbolizes the mission of the US as it applies to the total concept of national defense. The engineer's transit represents the integral part that the Civil Engineering mission plays in the overall Air Force scheme. (Approved, 8 Apr 1975)
