

38 MUNITIONS MAINTENANCE GROUP



MISSION

The group's mission was to "Defend, Maintain and Employ NATO's Premier Weapons to the Highest Possible Standards." The group directly supported the Belgian, German, Dutch and Italian Air Forces in executing their NATO strike mission.

The 38 MMG was a 10-person staff that provides command, leadership and support for over 550 active duty personnel from 20 career fields in four geographically separated units. The group oversaw the ownership, custody, maintenance and release of a \$2 billion US weapons stockpile and managed a \$1.1 million annual budget.

The 38 MMG was divided into the group staff and four geographically separated units:
