7-Aug-1943 41st Air Depot Repair Squadron departed Air Depot Training Station, Albuquerque, NM, by train, strength, 10 Officers, 340 enlisted men, destination: Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

10-Aug-43 41st arrived at Camp Kilmer, NJ

21-Aug-1943 41st Air Depot Repair Squadron left for overseas on SS Santa Elena from Staten Island, NY

4-Sep-1943 41st Air Depot Repair Squadron made camp at Air Corps Bivouac Area 3 miles north of Bizerte, Tunisia.

7-Sep 1943 41st arrives at Sidi Ahmed, Tunisia, North Africa

28-Nov-1943 41st Air Depot Repair Squadron sailed from Bizerti at 0800 for Taranto, Italy

4-Dec-1943 41st Air Depot Repair Squadron arrived at Bari Airport by motor transport from Taranto, Italy.

19-Dec-1943 41st Air Depot Repair Squadron left Bari Airport for new location at Gioia del Colle (AAF Advanced Depot #52).

17-Jul-1945 Received orders that the 41st ADRS was to be transferred to the AAF General Depot # 3, at Naples, Capodichina Air Field,

26-Jul-1945 Unit departed Gioia del Colle Airport, Gioia del Colle, Italy for AAF General Depot # 3 (Capodichino Air Depot), Naples, Italy.
