MISSION

The 49th Mission Support Group supports strategic national security objectives with combat-ready airmen and support to MQ-9 & F-16 formal training units. Provides engineer support, cyber-security, integrated defense, acquisitions, logistics, personnel, and services for over 18K active military, civilians, dependents, and contractors, as well as 24 mission partners from 4 different commands. Executes \$24.4M of non-appropriated/appropriated funds, oversees 66K acres, \$33M in civilian pay, and \$5.4B in infrastructure.
