Its mission was one of providing logistics support to USAF activities and insurance that such support was adequate and responsive. For the USAF Chief of Staff it maintained control of requisitioning, supplying and movement of materiel and personnel into and from the Zone of Interior, aerial and water port of embarkation.

3102nd (Gulf) at New Orleans Port of Embarkation, under MOAMA
