## OPERATIONS

With the assumption of aviation engineer training by the Corps of Engineers, Warren became a regular technical training base of the Air Training Command. Present courses include the automotive mechanics, clerk typists, and clerk stenographers which were transferred from Lowry in 1948. In 1949 the fixed wire schools were transferred from Scott AFB, Illinois to Warren offering

training in teletype operation and maintenance and in cable splicing, wire and telephone installation and repair. One holdover of the aviation engineer schools is the powerman course which began training as such in 1949 and the automotive school has expanded to include the special equipment operators course.
