EMBLEM

On an Air Force blue disc edged Air Force golden yellow, within a wide border edged Air Force blue and striped bendwise white and red, a white chain of seven links bendwise throughout

between a knight's head in profile Air Force golden yellow, the helmet trimmed with the SAC banner, light blue, spattered with white stars, and in dexter a red lightning flash and an Air Force golden yellow rifle in saltire, both pointing to dexter chief. Motto, on a white scroll, edged and inscribed Air Force blue, ECCE VIRI, Men to Behold. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the squadron and its mission. Against a deep blue background To represent the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations, a chain, indicating the unity und strength of the unit's security force, is displayed between a knight's head, representing the palace guard or elite guard assigned to provide security for Headquarters Strategic Air Command and a lightning bolt from the SAC emblem crossed with a rifle, indicating Instantaneous reaction and strike capability of the Combat Defense Force and SAC's Drill Team. The red and white striped border symbolizes guarding of restricted areas. The emblem bears the Air Force colors, ultramarine blue and golden yellow, and the national colors, rec, white, and blue.
