The Continental Air Command has Air Force Reserve Regions which administer reserve activities in various areas of the United States. Headquarters for the Sixth Air Force Reserve Region is here at Hamilton.

The mission of this region is to plan, direct and supervise the activities of 132 Air Force Reserve units in California, Oregon, Washington, Utah, Idaho, Montana, Alaska and Hawaii. Region headquarters at Hamilton is responsible for administrative, budgetary, logistical, personnel and recruiting support of these units. It also supervises their in-active duty training. Upon mobilization, reserve forces either by units or as individuals, are assigned to other major commands to support operational requirements.
