OPERATIONS

Originally, the 52 USAF Dispensary was organized as a section within the 77th Air Base Squadron, Suffolk County Air Force Base. The medical facility became an independent unit in February 1953, when the 519th USAF Infirmary was officially activated. In August 1955, Air Defense Command General Orders No. 35 and No. 37 deactivated the 519th USAF Infirmary and activated the 52 USAF Dispensary in May 1957.

Today, the 52 USAF Dispensary, Class "A" is a 10-operating bed facility which provides medical and dental care to all military personnel assigned or attached to Suffolk County Air Force Base. In addition, the facility provides out-patient medical care to the dependents of military personnel, who reside in the vicinity of Suffolk County Air Force Base.
