### EMBLEM

On an Air Force golden yellow disc bordered Air Force blue, an open hand, palm up bendwise, black voided of the field, surmounted bendwise by a white stylized missile in flight upward, edged Air Force blue; all between five Air Force blue stars arched from dexter chief to sinister and two

green olive branches arched from dexter to sinister. On a red scroll edged Air Force blue, inscribed red, ADJUVARE MANDATUM NOSTRUM, Our Mission is Support. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the squadron and its mission. The missile in flight upward toward the right, indicates its ability to go forward into battle. The hand indicates the unit's mission is to provide necessary support so the missile can achieve its mission. The five stars represent the five major sections of the squadron and the olive branches indicate the missile is supported for the maintenance of peace. The emblem bears the Air Force colors, ultra-marine blue and golden yellow. (Approved: 28 Jul 1960)
