The USAF Security Service, San Antonio, Texas directed discontinuance of a Hill AFB tenant, the 6985th Communications Security Depot Squadron. Personnel went to the Headquarters, 6936th Communications Security Depot Group. The Squadron had been at Hill AFB since July 1958. 1 MAR ???

A tenant at Hill AFB since July 1958, the 6985th Communications Security Depot Squadron was

directed to discontinue operations by the USAF Security Service, of San Antonio, Texas, 1 May 1963. Two Air Force Reserve organizations, the 7th Maintenance Squadron, Mobile, and the 7th Supply Squadron, Mobile Support, were activated and became Air Force Reserve tenants at Hill AFB on 1 July 1966. The gaining command, should they be mobilized, would be HQ AFLC.

The Hill AFB tenant the 6985th Communications Security Flight became the 6985th Communications Security Depot Squadron. 1 APR 1960
