On 8 May 1962, the 7367th Combat Support Group, consisting of the HQ Squadron, 7367th Air Police Sq, 7367th Material Sq, and the 7637th USAF Dispensary was activated to operate Chambley after departure of the 7122d Wing. The 7367th reported to the newly formed 366th Tactical Fighter Wing at Chaumont AB and supported its 390th Tactical Fighter Squadron that would fly F-84Fs from Chambley. The 390th had twenty F-84Fs and was manned by twenty-seven officers and seven airmen. The 7367th had one officer and one airman on 8 May, but by January 1963 it
