MISSION

The 90 Mission Support Group provides world-class combat support enabling the 90 Missile Wing's mission while preparing and deploying warrior airmen to combatant commands world-wide. The 1,000 men and women of the group provide civil engineering, transportation and logistics, communications, contracting, and personnel and services support to 29,000 active duty, Reserve, family members and retirees, including over 3,815 personnel assigned to the missile wing and tenant units.

This diverse group fully supports the nuclear mission while maintaining a robust overseas deployment commitment providing combat capability across the spectrum of conflict. The units of the 90 Mission Support Group include the 90 Civil Engineer Squadron, 90 Logistics Readiness Squadron, 90 Communications Squadron, 90 Contracting Squadron, and the 90 Force Support Squadron.
