EMBLEM

On a disc as a globe throughout Azure, gridlined Argent surmounted by a cross Gules, all within a narrow border Blue. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "NOT WITHOUT US" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "92D MEDICAL SUPPORT SQ" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe represents the worldwide medical support provided to personnel by the Squadron. The cross symbolizes support in emergency situations throughout the world. Emblem. (Approved, 16 Oct 2008)
